Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.139 dated 26.7.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 420, 384, 354, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Division No.5, Jalandhar (**Annexure P-1**).

As per the allegations, the petitioner along with his co-accused Kuldeep Kaur and son Goldy came to the house of the complainant for taking household articles. Apart from that petitioner who is working in Home Guard Department, Punjab Police also demanded a sum of Rs.20,000/- from the complainant failing which he would implicate her in the false case.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the entire allegations are vague and no offence is made out. He further submits that after the grant of interim protection by this Court, vide order dated 20.10.2015, the petitioner/accused has since joined the investigations.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Surinder Pal Singh, concedes that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, interim pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 20.10.2015, is made absolute.
