Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No.134,

dated 13.08.2011, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B, IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Head-constable Pawan Kumar submits that in the case in hand, the challan as provided under Section 173, Cr.P.C. has already been presented in the court on 01.05.2012 and proceedings before the trial court are pending thereafter.

Since the challan has already been presented in the court and the case is fixed for framing of charge, learned counsel for the petitioner prays that present petition be dismissed as withdrawn and personal appearance of the petitioner may kindly be exempted as he is around 75 years of age, .

Dismissed as withdrawn.

The trial court shall exempt the personal appearance of the petitioner unless it is specifically required.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is at liberty to raise all the pleas available to him, at the time of framing of charge.
