By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.53, dated 10.05.2013, registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 474 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Phase-8, Mohali.

It is contended that the petitioner is a property dealer and is not named in the FIR. He has been falsely implicated in the instant case only on the basis of certain telephonic calls made and received from the co-accused, Gurmit Singh. In pursuance of the order dated 08.10.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that

the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 08.10.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
