Petitioner is a lady who seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of Malwinder Singh alleging that the petitioner connived with her co-accused and forged a power of attorney of his sister and sister-in-law by forging their signatures. So far as petitioner is concerned, she had allegedly impersonated as Harwinder Kaur sister of the complainant before Sub Registrar and made an attempt to alienate the property in connivance with Jagatjit Singh, a property dealer.

The allegations against the petitioner are though serious but fact remains that no wrongful loss had been caused to the complainant by the time fraud was detected.

Taking into consideration the fact that the petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 02.08.2015 and co-accused of the petitioner Harpreet Singh having been granted concession on bail, on the principle of parity, the petitioner can be granted the concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that she will not leave India without the permission of the Court and will not commit any similar offence of which she is accused of during pendency of the trial.
