Petitioners seek pre-arrest bail in FIR No. 310 dated 15.6.2015 registered under Sections 323, 506 and 34 IPC (Section 307 IPC was added later on) at Police Station Sampla, District Rohtak.

Notice of motion was issued and interim protection was granted to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Rajbir Singh, Police Station, Sampla, submits that in compliance of the order passed by this Court, petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for any further investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant also could not raise any allegation against the petitioners regarding any attempt for misusing the concession of interim anticipatory bail granted by this Court to them.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 7.10.2015 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute, however, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
