The petitioner Virender has applied for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.57, dated 13.02.2014, under Sections 365, 395, 171 of IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Gohana.

The law was set in motion by recording the statement of Satywan Sharma who was stated that at about 10.30.pm his vehicle bearing registration No.RJ-32-GA-7040 had started from IOCL, Polymar Panipat to Alwar after loading plastic dana. Vijender son of Jagdish Parshad Yadav was driver on said vehicle. 800 bags i.e. 20 tons of plastic dana was loaded in the vehicle. At about 10.30.pm when the vehicle reached Gohana By pass then a vehicle with a red light affix on it came in front of his vehicle and stopped and 4 young persons came out of it in police uniform and took out Vijender from his vehicle and forcibly took him in their vehicle.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the name

of the petitioner does not figure in the FIR even Virender has given the name of four persons namely Sunil, Sandeep, Amit and Krishan and has not mentioned about the name of petitioner. Except recovery of Rs.5,000/- all other recoveries had been effected from Sunil, Sandeep, Amit and Krishan.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jagdeep Singh has submitted that another case is registered against the petitioner at Police Station Bhiwani under Section 395 of IPC is pending and the co-accused has made disclosure statement against the petitioner.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 02.05.2014. In the original version given by Virender four names have been given and applicant name is not included. So, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition stands accepted, the petitioner Virender is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Sonapat.
