Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking regular bail in FIR No.69 dated 19.07.2015, under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985 ('Act' for short), registered at Police Station Kotbhai, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

As per the prosecution case, petitioner and his co-accused were found in possession of the contraband, which were recovered from the Car in which they were traveling.

Petitioner is in custody since 19.07.2015. Petitioner was found innocent on the basis of enquiry conducted by Superintendent of Police (Detective). Application was moved by the prosecution for discharge of

the petitioner but the said application was dismissed by the trial Court.

On a query put by this Court, learned State counsel on instructions from Head Constable Kuljit Singh has submitted that the petitioner is not involved in any other case under the Act.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, it would be just and expedient to order the release of the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail subject to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sri Muktsar Sahib.
