Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.24 dated 13.02.2015, under Sections 15, 22, 25, 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985, Section 489 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Samana, District Patiala.

While issuing notice motion, following order was passed by this Court on 07.10.2015:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner was not apprehended at the spot. In fact, the brother of the petitioner was apprehended with the contraband while he was travelling in his Car. Petitioner had been falsely involved in this case being brother of his co-accused. Gurbhej Singh @

Bheja brother of the petitioner has died while he was in custody and his bhog ceremony is to take place on 08.10.2015.

Notice of motion for 10.12.2015.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, petitioner be admitted to interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. Petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973."

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Parkash Masih has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioner by this Court vide order dated 07.10.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
