Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.147 dated 9.9.2015 under Sections 341, 323 and 506 read with Section 34 IPC (Sections 353 and 386 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Kurali, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

This Court vide order dated 7.10.2015 has granted interim bail to the petitioners subject to compliance of provisions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Harbhajan Singh also states that the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioners vide order dated 7.10.2015 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
