Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking regular bail in FIR No.12 dated 14.03.2014, under Sections 363, 366, 376, 506, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Dera Baba Nanak Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Heard.

Prosecution story, in brief, is that the petitioner had committed the offence of abduction and rape.

Petitioner is in custody since 16.03.2014. A perusal of Annexure P-6 cross-examination of the prosecutrix recorded during trial reveals that she had

admitted her signatures on marriage certificate exhibit D-1. She had also admitted the photographs D2 to D-4 which were clicked at Gurudwara Guru Nanak Devi Ji, Phase-VI, Sahibzada Ajit Singh Nagar, Mohali. She had also admitted that her parents were not agreeable qua her marriage with the petitioner Jaspreet Singh.

Keeping in view the above facts, it would be just and expedient to order the release of the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on merits on the case, this petition is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail, subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurdaspur.
