Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.78 dated 07.08.2013, registered under Sections 15 of the NDPS Act, Police Station Sadar Raikot, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 08.10.2015, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has cooperated.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Head Constable Ravinder Kumar has also stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custody is not required.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 08.10.2015 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
