The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.131, dated 30.11.2014, registered under Sections 22, 61, 85 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Ajitwal.

In this case, the recovery is 150 grams of intoxicating powder which is commercial quantity. It is not disputed that the petitioner remained on interim bail during the time the matter was pending with the FSL and now the report has come that the recovered material was indeed contraband.

No ground is made out to release the petitioner on regular bail in view of

the provisions of Section 37 of the NDPS Act. Consequently, this petition is dismissed.
