SNEH PRASHAR, J.

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioners in case First Information Report No.106 dated 13.08.2014 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 285, 427, 452, 332, 353, 186, 307 and 419 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC) and Section 25 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Sadar, Jagadhri, Yamuna Nagar.

2. Heard the submissions made by Mr. Jatinder Nagpal, Advocate representing the petitioners and Ms. Mahima, AAG, Haryana representing the State.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that injured Aanchal has since been examined but she has not identified the petitioners as the assailants in her deposition before the trial Court. Submitting that the petitioners are in custody since 14.08.2014.

Learned counsel prayed that they be enlarged on regular bail.

4. The prayer is opposed by learned State counsel and she prays for dismissal of the present petition.

5. Taking into consideration the fact that the trial is still likely to take time and there is no plausible ground to detain petitioners in custody, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioners are released on bail subject to their furnishing bail/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri.
