JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The prayer is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.85 dated 22.09.2013, under Sections 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered with Police Station Dugri, Ludhiana City (**Annexure P-1**).

As per the allegations, a recovery of 400 tablets of Mahroon colour of Dextroprophehene Hydrochloride, 104 tablets of blue colour of Dextroprophehene Napsylate and 400 tablets of white colour of Diphenoxylate Hydrochloride has been made from the person of petitioner/accused.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused submits that even the quantity of the alleged recovery is non-commercial in nature. He further submits that there is no other case registered or pending against the petitioner. He further submits that the petitioner is in custody since 22.09.2013 and challan has been presented.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sulakhan Singh, concedes regarding the custody period, the fact that no other case is pending against the petitioner and that the investigations are over.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the custody period, investigations are over and the seizure being of non-commercial in nature, this Court finds that petitioner/accused deserves the concession of regular bail and as such he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
