Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners namely Bobby Nath, Bhuchar Nath and Sadhu Nath in case FIR No.60 dated 06.09.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 341, 342, 354, 354-A, 323, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Bhadaur, District Barnala.

To resolve the matrimonial dispute between petitioner no.1 Bobby Nath and his complainant wife of 20 years a meeting had taken place between the relatives which erupted into a free-for-all fight.

There is version and cross version of the case.

Three petitioners are husband, husband's brother and uncle seeking anticipatory bail.

The injuries attributed to the petitioners are stated to be simple in nature, however to make offences serious a false version of dragging the wife inside a house has been made.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Paramjit Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioners have joined the investigation and are no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 08th of October, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
