JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The prayer is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.49 dated 27.04.2015, under Sections 18/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered with Police Station Sadar, Phagwara, District Kapurthala (**Annexure P-1**).

As per the allegations, recovery of 6 Kg. of *opium* was effected from the person of the present petitioner/accused.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 27.04.2015 and not involved in any other case.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from S.I. Mohan Lal, states that no doubt investigations are over and case is at the stage of framing of charge, however, keeping in view the commercial nature of the quantity, no case for bail is made out.

Keeping in view the alleged recovery being commercial in nature, this Court finds no ground for grant of regular bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
