Prayer is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.PC to the petitioner Beant Singh in case FIR No.104 dated 12.09.2013 for offences punishable under Sections 22, 61 & 85 of the NDPS Act registered with Police Station Ghagga, District Patiala.

The recovery of 1250 intoxicant tablets containing salt Diphenoxylate were recovered from the possession of the petitioner.

Since the challan could not be presented within the stipulated 180 days, the petitioner was released on bail on 15.5.2014 in the light of the provisions of Section 167(2) Cr.PC. Due to his absence on 08.01.2015 before the trial Court, his bail bonds were cancelled and NBWs were issued. Thereafter the petitioner surrendered on 12.6.2015 and is stated to be in custody. Hence the prayer for present bail.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Saheb Singh submits that the seized contraband is commercial in nature and the case is now fixed for prosecution evidence for 19.10.2015. In the light of the previous experience, no case for bail would be made out.

In view of the above, no case for bail is made out.

Dismissed.
