RITU BAHRI, J.

This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and further to ensure that they may not be harassed by respondent Nos. 4 and 5, as they have solemnized marriage against the wishes of their parents.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, has informed the Court that statements of Ranjan Bala and Raj Kumar-petitioners have been recorded on 10.11.2014 to the effect that now they do not apprehend danger from any one, therefore, they do not require protection any longer. Statements of the petitioners are taken on record as Annexures A-1 and A-2.

In view of the statements made by the petitioners before the police, no further orders are required to be passed in this petition.

Disposed of accordingly.
