AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.51 dated 16.04.2014 registered under Sections 307/323/324/326/427/148/149 IPC at Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the alleged victim was discharged from hospital long time ago.

Learned Additional Advocate General, on instructions from ASI Sukhdev Raj, has accepted this fact.

Keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of bail to the present petitioner.
