AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.291 dated 15.08.2015, registered under Section 420 IPC, at Police Station A-Division, Amritsar City, Amritsar.

On 16.10.2015 the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel has argued that apart from the merits the fact of the matter is that the challan was presented on the 61st day and even though this ground may not have been specifically taken up in this petition but it has given the petitioner a right to be released on bail. On instructions from ASI Rajinder Singh, learned Addl.A.G. has accepted theft act

that the challan was presented on the 61st day. On being asked why the challan was filed on the 61st day, learned Addl. A.G seeks a short adjournment to file the affidavit of the investigating officer.

Adjourned to 04.12.2015.

In the meantime the petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.”

Affidavit of Rajinder Singh, ASI has been filed pursuant to the order dated 16.10.2015. Explanation is accepted.

In the circumstances, the interim bail granted by the trial Court is made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
