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**ANITA CHAUDHRY, J(ORAL)**

Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.130 dated 13.06.2014, registered under Sections 406/498-A/506 IPC, Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 17.10.2014, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has co-operated.

Learned State counsel has also stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that recovery is still to be effected.

Custodial interrogation is not necessary to recover the dowry articles. The police can make recovery even otherwise. Looking to the circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 17.10.2014 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
