RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner, by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeks quashing of FIR No.227 dated 28.11.2010 under Sections 109, 115, 195, 211, 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Rama Mandi, District Jalandhar.

Notice of motion was issued and pursuant thereto, reply was filed.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Inspector Palwinder Singh, Police Station Rama Mandi, District Jalandhar, submits that during pendency of the present petition, cancellation report was prepared in favour of the petitioner. It was approved by the ACP (Central), Jalandhar. It was further approved by ADCP (City)-I, Jalandhar. Thereafter, the cancellation report is pending approval of the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar since 24.06.2013. She further submits that the cancellation report

could not be presented to the learned Court of competent jurisdiction, because this Court while issuing notice of motion on 07.02.2011, stayed the further proceedings qua the petitioner. However, learned counsel for the State now submits that in view of the cancellation report having been prepared, present petition does not survive and the same may be disposed of, as such.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner fairly states that let the present petition be disposed of, in view of the statement made by learned counsel for the State. Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar may be directed to ensure presentation of the cancellation report, before the learned Court of competent jurisdiction without any further loss of time.

In view of the above, instant petition is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous. However, Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar is directed to ensure that cancellation report pending for his approval for the last more than two years, be ensured to be presented to the learned Court of competent jurisdiction without any further loss of time and in any case within a period of three weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present petition stands disposed of.
