REKHA MITTAL, J.

The present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (in short 'Cr.P.C.') has been filed seeking quashing of FIR No.54 dated 11.05.2013 registered in Police Station Kotisan Khan, District Moga for offence punishable under Sections 376, 323 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code (in short 'IPC') on the basis of affidavit dated 25.02.2014 of the complainant.

Keeping in view the gravity of allegations set up in the First Information Report when examined in the light of judgments of Hon'ble the Supreme Court of India in *Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another, 2012 (4) R.C.R. (Criminal) 543*, I do not think it to be a fit case wherein interference in exercise of inherent jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is warranted.

Dismissed.
