JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.206 dated 16.09.2015, under Sections 452, 323, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Kotwali, District Patiala.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Joginder Singh, submits that two other co-accused, who are sons of the petitioner/accused, were granted anticipatory bail by learned trial Court and have chosen to stay away from joining the investigation. As regards the present petitioner, it is submitted that she is alleged to have inflicted a *Knife* blow on the thigh of the complainant and as such the recovery of the *knife* is to be effected.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
