By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.84, dated 04.09.2015, registered under Sections 307, 120-B IPC, at Police Station Ghuman, Batala, District Gurdaspur.

It is contended that the petitioner No.1 is sister in law whereas petitioner No.2 is cousin of husband of the complainant who are residing separately. In pursuance of the order dated 08.10.2015, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that

the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 08.10.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
