Petitioners seek quashing of impugned FIR on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Notice of motion was issued vide order dated 8.10.2015 and the parties were directed to appear before the learned trial Court on or before 12.10.2015 for getting their statements recorded, so as to enable the learned trial Court to record its satisfaction about the genuineness of compromise.

Report dated 14.10.2015 has been received from the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana through the learned District & Sessions Judge, Ludhiana to the effect that all the parties did not come present before the learned trial Court on or before 12.10.2015 for getting their statements recorded.

When the case came up for hearing on 27.11.2015, none appeared on behalf of the petitioners. Similar is the position today. Neither anybody has come present on behalf of the petitioners nor any request for pass over has been made. It seems that petitioners are no more interested in pursuing the present petition.

In view of the above, instant petition is disposed of, with liberty to the petitioners to file fresh one on the same cause of action, as and when necessity arises.

Disposed of, accordingly.
