The petitioner has filed the petition to seek protection of life and liberty on the basis of alleged threat at the hands of respondent nos.5 to 7, who are husband, father and a close relative of her husband, respectively. The case of the petitioner is that after marriage with respondent no.5 she stayed with him for about 13 years and now the petitioner is living separately as her husband is drug addict. The father and brother of the petitioner are also forcing her to live with her husband and in-laws.

Presently, the petitioner is residing at the house of her relative i.e. Daughter of her aunt. The petitioner is alleged to have given representation in this regard to the police as well.

The prayer made by the petitioner is not acceptable as the allegations made do not inspire confidence as the petition itself does not disclose anything that the respondent nos.5 to 7 ever visited the place where

the petitioner is residing to extend the threats or by any other manner. The petitioner is living separately and independently by her own choice and there is no interference on the part of respondent nos.5 to 7 is alleged in the petition.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to interfere under Section 482 Cr.PC for issuance of any such directions as prayed for and as such the present petition is hereby dismissed.
