Report dated 23.03.2015 sent by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Nakodar has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Bhajan Singh, Lakhbir Singh, Sukhjeet Singh @ Sita and Jasbir Singh as well as of complainant Satinder Kaur it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view the nature of offence and that the parties belong to the same very village have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and to bring about harmonious atmosphere and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.174 dated 10.07.2010 under Sections 323,324,452,427,379,148,149 IPC, Police Station, Nakodar

District Jalandhar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.
