Learned counsel for respondent No.2-complainant has put in appearance to state that the matter has been compromised.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he had taken loan from the complainant for a sum of Rs. 5 lacs against cheques which were dishonored.

In view of matter having been compromised before presentation of challan, this petition is disposed of with a direction that supplementary statement of the complainant will be recorded by the investigating officer within a period of one month. On the basis of said statement, it will be open to the prosecution agency to present cancellation/untraced report. In case, any such report is submitted, the Illaqa Magistrate shall accept the same on no objection having been submitted by the complainant.
