This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to the respondent-State to present challan in FIR No.50 dated 27.05.2015 registered under Sections 376/354/420/494 IPC at Police Station Division No.3, Ludhiana.

On the asking of the Court, Ms.Amarjit Kaur Khurana, Addl. AG, Punjab and Mr. Bipan Ghai, Senior Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 and respondent No.5 respectively.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to supply requisite copies of the petition to both counsel during the course of the day.

Learned Additional Advocate General has stated that since the prayer of the accused for anticipatory bail was also fixed today the Investigating Officer is here and on his instructions has stated that the final challan shall be filed within one month.

Learned counsel for respondent No.5 prays that keeping in view the sensitivity and seriousness of the matter, the trial Court be directed to finally decide the case within any reasonable time and he undertakes that the complainant will appear on the first date of evidence and give his statement.

In the circumstances trial Court is directed to conclude the trial within one year.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
