DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

The present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 46 dated 3.5.2014 registered under Sections 307,323,324,427,148/149 IPC at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. The injury attributed to the petitioner is simple in nature and he is behind the bars since 12.5.2014. Learned counsel further contends that till now even a single witness has not been examined and no purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in custody.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State has not disputed the

custody period as well as nature of injury.

Keeping in views the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and also the facts that the petitioner is in custody since 12.5.2014; even a single witness has not been examined so far; the injury attributed to the petitioner is simple in nature and no purpose would be served by keeping him in custody, petition is allowed. Petitioner-Jatinder @ Bholu @ Sonu is directed to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
