This petition has been moved by the petitioner under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 871 dated 28.08.2014, under Section 306 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code of Police Station City Sirsa.

State counsel has placed on record documents from which handwriting on the suicide note was compared and it is submitted that the report from the FSL is that the date on the suicide note was in the handwriting of the deceased concerned.

Sanjeev Kumar died on 28.08.2014, whereas the suicide note bears the date as 29.08.2014. Whether or not the same was the result of mental disturbance would be seen during the trial.

It is submitted by counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner had joined investigation and now charge-sheet stands filed in Court and it is

affirmed by ASI Jagga Singh of Police Station City Sirsa, who is present in Court, that the petitioner had joined investigation before the charge-sheet was filed.

In view of the above, the interim relief granted to the petitioner on 09.10.2014 is made absolute.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
