Petitioner, by way of instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure ('Cr.P.C.' for short), seeks appropriate directions to the respondent authorities for conducting investigation in just and fair manner, making arrest of the accused and submit the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C., expeditiously in FIR No.53 dated 20.05.2013 under Sections 379, 447, 427, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Naya Gaon, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

Notice of motion was issued and pursuant thereto, status report by way of affidavit dated 31.05.2015 has been filed.

Learned counsel for the State, while referring the averments taken in para 1 of the preliminary submissions, submits that after conducting the effective investigation, cancellation report has already been prepared in the present case, rendering the present petition as infructuous.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to pursue his other remedies, in accordance with law.
