The prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.125 dated 27.06.2015, under Sections 406, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Rajpura City, District Patiala (**Annexure P-1**).

As per the allegations levelled by the complainant-Gurinderpal Singh, the petitioner/accused is alleged to have affixed the signatures of her husband-Jaswinder Singh on the agreement to sell dated 25.09.2007 qua the sale of his share.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused submits that the present petition has become infructuous since the petitioner has already been arrested.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Surjit Singh, does not refute the aforesaid factual position.

In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
