By way of first petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.121, dated 24.11.2012, registered under Sections 406/419/420/467/468/471 of the Indian Penal Code (for the 'the IPC') at Police Station Rajendra Park, District Gurgaon.

The learned counsel, inter alia, contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused Dushyant @ Dev. The alleged amount have been received by three persons namely Ajay Kumar, Shailesh Pipal and Sanjeev Kashyap through their bank accounts.

Heard.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner had duped the complainants by representing him as an employee of DCP Bank and

obtained two cheques from them for getting their shops on rent for the ATM of said bank and bad antecedents of the petitioner, no case is made out for bail.

Dismissed.
