INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has preferred the instant application under Section 439 Cr.P.C., seeking regular bail in case FIR No.468 dated 29.08.2015, registered at Police Station Manimajra, Chandigarh, under Sections 399, 401, 34 IPC.

Notice of motion.

Mr. G.S.Chahal, Additional Public Prosecutor, who is present in Court, has accepted notice on behalf of respondent(s)- State and contested this petition. Police record is also available.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the FIR in the present case has been registered on the basis of secret information against the petitioner that he alongwith other persons is present at jungle situated at backside Hotel Solitaire and is jointly preparing to loot ATM. A raid was conducted. From the possession of the petitioner, knife was recovered. The petitioner is in custody since 29.08.2015. No other case is registered against him. The petitioner is in judicial

custody and he is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes. The presentation of challan as well as the trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody.

Therefore, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merit of the case, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of ₹ 40,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Chandigarh.
