The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for a direction to respondent No.2 to withdraw the “Look Out Circular” issued against the petitioner in First Information Report No.373 dated 19.11.2009, under Section 420, 467, 468, 471, 474 and 120-B of the Indian Penal code, registered at Police Station Sector-17 Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for U. T Chandigarh has filed report of Sanjay Dutt, Asstt. Sub Inspector, in Court today and the same is taken on record. It is mentioned in the report that the case has reached the stage of prosecution evidence and the “Look Out Circular” was issued against the petitioner because there was apprehension that she may

escape from India to some foreign country. Learned counsel for U.T. Submitted that they have no objection to the withdrawal of the “Look Out Circular” in case the petitioner submits her passport with learned trial Court.

In view of the submission, petitioner is directed to submit her passport with learned trial Court and on submission of the same they will withdraw the “Look Out Circular” issued against the petitioner. As and when the petitioner requires the passport she will be at liberty to approach the trial Court for release of the same on superdari.

In the above terms the present petition is disposed of .
