Report dated 19.11.2015 sent by learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Patti has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Jagjit Singh @ Jagga, Kuldeep Singh, Lakhwinder Singh and Nasib Kaur as well as of complainant Harjinder Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052,** FIR No.73 dated 11.04.2013 under Sections 392, 120 IPC, Police Station, Patti, District Tarn Taran and all other consequential

proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
