By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.118, dated 20.06.2015, registered under Sections 323, 336, 427, 341, 148 149 Indian Penal Code (IPC), Sections 325 IPC (added lateron) and Section 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act, at Police Station City Rupnagar.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order dated 09.10.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation and the recovery has been effected from him and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 09.10.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
