Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner in case FIR No.69 dated 28.08.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Rawalpindi Phagwara, District Kapurthala (**Annexure P-1**).

As per the allegations, petitioner/accused-Baljit Kaur by using forged documents has procured a fake Passport in the name of Smt. Balbir Kaur.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has since joined the investigation and surrendered the said Passport.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Sucha Singh, concedes that the petitioner has joined the investigation, surrendered the said Passport and her custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the above, interim pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 29.10.2015, is made absolute.
