By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.228, dated 29.08.2015, registered under Sections 120-B, 465, 458, 471, 419 of the Indian Penal Code (IPC), at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur.

The learned counsel for the petitioners contends that in pursuance of the order dated 16.10.2015, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 16.10.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
