FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Report dated 17.12.2015 sent by learned Civil Judge (Junior Division) Batala has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Sukhwinder Singh, Dalbir Singh @ Bino, Kartar Singh, Balwinder Singh as well as of complainant Randhir Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is case of cross-version and offences are not heinous in nature and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, rapat No.10, dated 07.08.2014 in FIR No.65 dated 03.08.2014 under Sections 323,324,34 IPC, Police Station, Qila Lal Singh, District

Gurdaspur and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.
