CRM-M No. 37590 of 2013

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal
Procedure, 1973, for quashing of FIR No. 203 dated 23.09.2010, under
Sections 186, 353, 427, 506 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code,
Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar (Annexure P-1) and all other
consequential proceedings arising there-from, on the basis of compromise.

In compliance with the order dated 10.01.2014 passed by this

Court, Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar, recorded the statements of the parties and also submitted a report that from the statements, it appeared that compromise had been voluntarily entered into between the parties.

Complainant – Deepak Sharma is present in Court, who has been questioned and he has convinced the Court that the compromise was made by him without any pressure from any quarter.

Learned counsel for the parties have stated at the bar that the matter has been compromised between the parties.

So, in view of the above circumstances and the authority reported as '**Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others, 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**', the petition is allowed and the above-said FIR and the proceedings arising out there-from are hereby quashed.
