Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail on behalf of husband of the complainant-Rachna in case FIR No.167 dated 15.07.2015, under Sections 406 and 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Model Town, District Hoshiarpur (**Annexure P-1**).

The marriage between the petitioner-Vivek Vasudev and complainant-Rachna was solemnized on 01.07.2014. The complainant-Rachna has leveled serious allegations of beatings for bringing insufficient dowry as also consistent demands of Rs.5 Lacs and a Car from her parents.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case as there is no specific allegation against him.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by HC Gurmukh Singh, submits that although the petitioner has joined the investigation but dowry articles are yet to be recovered.

After hearing learned Counsel for the parties, keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
