Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.47 dated 14.08.2015, under Sections 411, 414, 489-A, 489-B, 489-C, 489-D of the Indian Penal Code, Sections 15/18/21/22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, Section 14 of the Foreigners Act, 1946 and Section 3 of the Indian Passport Act, 1920, registered with Police Station Sarai Amanat Khan, District Amritsar City (**Annexure P-1**).

As per the allegations, the petitioner/accused along with 29 other accused belonging to different villages are alleged to be indulging in international smuggling of drugs.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused submits that after the grant of interim protection by this Court, while issuing notice of motion on 12.10.2015, the petitioner/accused has since joined the investigations.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from A.S.I. Harvinder Pal Singh, concedes that in terms of the order dated 12.10.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, interim pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 12.10.2015, is made absolute.
