For the reasons recorded, this application is allowed and the document (Annexure P-3) is taken on record.

CRM-M No.34978 of 2014

The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 52, dated 8.5.2014, registered under Sections 323, 324, 341, 307 of the IPC, at Police Station Bhindi Saidan, District Amritsar (Rural).

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that there was delay of 3 days in lodging the FIR, further delay of 3 weeks in invoking Section 307 of the IPC, the complainant was discharged from hospital within 10 days, and

that the petitioner has now been in custody for more than six months.

Counsel for the respondent, on instructions from ASI Pargat Singh, has accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of bail to the petitioner. Consequently, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of.
