AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

The aforesaid two petitions have been filed for the grant of regular bail in case bearing FIR No. 38 dated 29.04.2015 registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC, Section 12 of the Passport Act, 1967 and Section 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, at Police Station Sadar Banga, District SBS Nagar. Since they both have arisen out of a common FIR, the same are being decided by this common order. For discussion CRM-M-34953-2015 is being taken.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that similarly situated

co-accused was granted bail by order dated 29.09.2015 in case bearing CRM-M No. 31090 of 2015. The petitioner has undergone more than 1½ years. Learned Addl.AG, on instructions from ASI Kirpal Singh, has accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of bail to the present petitioner.
