Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner namely Jagpreet Ram @ Jaspreet Singh in case FIR No.58 dated 14.09.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 307, 324, 323, 506, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Nandgarh, District Bathinda.

It is contended that the petitioner is a 17-1/2 years old minor and even as per FIR, no role has been attributed. He further submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and nothing more is to be recovered from him.

Learned State Counsel assisted by learned Counsel for the complainant and ASI Bhalla Singh submits that petitioner has been attributed to have given three blows of baseball bat on injured Lakhvir Singh. The injuries are stated to be on the left side of the head and right finger of the right hand and ankle. That apart, the allegation is that the petitioner was accompanying rest of the co-accused and attacked the complainant party being peeved at for being restrained from the alleged eve teasing of girls.

Keeping in view the manner and nature of allegations and injuries, no case for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.
