By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.156, dated 28.12.2013, registered under Sections 323/324/452/34 of the Indian Penal Code (IPC) and Section 307 IPC (added lateron), at Police Station Mehta, District Amritsar Rural.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of the order dated 12.10.2015, the petitioner has appeared/surrendered before the trial Court and furnished the fresh bail bonds/surety bonds.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has

appeared/surrendered before the trial Court and furnished the fresh bail bonds/surety bonds.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 12.10.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
