INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioners Gurmit Singh, Sardool Singh and Shingara Singh have preferred this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.368 dated 29.09.2014, registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran, under Section 420 IPC.

Notice of motion was issued.

Today, learned State counsel has appeared and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

As per prosecution version, FIR has been registered on the statement of Lishkara Singh, in which he has stated that accused Bara Singh in connivance with accused Gurmit Singh, Sardul Singh, Shingara Singh etc. executed sale deed qua land measuring 1 kanal 6 marlas which was under mortgaged with him (complainant) and Bara Singh has no right to sell it. As per learned State counsel, the petitioners have already joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and the facts that the petitioners have already joined the investigation; they are not required for custodial interrogation and the case is based on facts and documentary evidence, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 07.01.2015, passed by this Court, granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.
